
### Archdiocese of Roseau, Dominica

It is dedicated to integral human development and providing courses for adult faith formation such as Retreats and Workshops for various groups especially of the students and teachers from Catholic Schools. In 2013/14, a total of 1,400 Students and Teachers benefited from those programmes. We seek to raise funds to help keep the programmes ongoing.

### **Peter Munk Cadriac Centre**

Your donations support the Peter Munk Cardiac Centre, Toronto General Hospital, toward the necessary development of smart technology that will reduce heart failure re-hospitalizations by identifying symptoms before they become problematic. This support will help to make Toronto and the Peter Munk Cardiac Centre an internationally-recognized and



sought-after site for heart failure research and treatment. We seek to raise funds to help provide technology needed to make the goal of optimizing outcomes, improving quality of life, and reducing readmission to hospital for patients with heart failure a reality.

### The Mackenzie Health Foundation



The Mackenzie Health Foundation installed a new 3T MRI Scanner in fall 2014, with improved imaging capabilities. The new MRI is bigger and completes scans quicker enabling professionals to perform two additional scans a day. The Mackenzie Health Foundation has achieved the highest MRI efficiency rates in the Province and the lowest wait times in the Central Local Health Integrated Network (LHIN).

On February 20, 2015, A Touch of Love and Hope proudly pledged \$10,000 to Mackenzie Health Foundation which helped to successfully achieve their \$5 million goal for the new MRI Scanner. At a ceremony held on March 27, 2015,



Mackenzie Health Foundation unveiled its Donor Wall which includes, among the Donors – A Touch of Love and Hope, representing all our Patrons, Board of Directors, volunteers and members.

During the 15 years I spent helping to improve Arts and Culture in York Region, I never thought of co-founding A Touch of Love and Hope Foundation. Although I remain an avid "Affezionata dell'Opera", the tremendous satisfaction I get from the work we do at A Touch of Love and Hope Foundation surpasses my love for the Arts.

I feel great fulfillment from bringing diverse community stakeholders together to affect positive change in people's lives. Together we are doing this by: issuing scholarships to mentally and physically challenged children at the Alpha Centre, and supporting projects of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Roseau, both in the Commonwealth of Dominica; supporting a state of the Art MRI Scanner at the Mackenzie Health Foundation. Richmond Hill; Dr. Heather Ross's work at the Peter Munk Cardiac Centre, Toronto General Hospital, and providing Social Services for Seniors in the Greater Toronto Area.

2016 was a very exciting year for A Touch of Love and Hope Foundation. Together, we made great strides in bringing the organization forward. Among other things,

we donated \$10,000 to our beneficiaries in Dominica and the Greater Toronto Area including issuing a scholarship to a mentally and physically challenged child at the Alpha Centre, Dominica.

With the support of a grant received from the Ontario Seniors Secretariat, we produced, in association with the Vaughan Community Health Centre, a very successful Health and Wellness Fair for 150 Seniors in Vaughan. The seminar was dedicated not only to the prevention and self-management of diabetes, diet and physical fitness, but also to keep the Seniors active in their communities. Two of the Seniors who attended the Fair, went on to serve on our 2017 Gala Committee and several others joined the organization as volunteers.

A Touch of Love and Hope Foundation was approved for a second government grant, this time from Heritage Canada. These funds are directed towards a multi-cultural event, in celebration of Canada's 150th Anniversary of Confederation. This event will be held in July in Woodbridge. I would like to take this opportunity, on behalf of the Board of Directors and Honorary Board, to extend our gratitude to the Ontario

and Canadian Governments for placing their trust in





### Commonwealth of Dominica

Known as the "Nature Isle" for its lush bounty, Dominica is a mountainous island in the Windward archipelago of the Caribbean Sea. It boasts complex rainforests, 365 rivers, healing sulfur springs, a boiling lake and beauties such as the Emerald Pool and Trafalgar Falls. Dominica is strengthened by the roots of its Aboriginal Caribs, warriors in canoes, who today are protected with the only remaining Carib Territory.

Dominicans are: proud, generous, family-oriented, faithloving, fun-loving, and independent people. Its people are ambitious and committed to continually improving themselves.

On November 3, 1493, Christopher Columbus named the Island after the day of the week on which he spotted it – a Sunday (Dominica in Latin). It has been independent from Great Britain since 1978 and unofficially speaks Creole (French patois). Its mix of English, French, African, and Carib influences are visible in its people, government, and architecture; as well as its culture, music, and celebrations such as Carnival and the World Creole Music Festival.
